NOW WHAT DO I DO?

- 1-Remember you need to do 3 road drives with instructor, and also 3 observations with an instructor.
- 2-When you have finished with your roads and observations you will need to take a road test with either the state or a 3rd party or private road test school. To make things easier schedule a test online through the state web site.

3- When you have passed the road test it is now time to get your license. You will need to present the following info to the Drivers License Division.

- a-Provide Social Security Card or Tax Id
- b- Parent or legal guardian must accompany you if you are under 18
- *c-License fee of \$30.00*
- d-Birth Certificate, the original or certified copy
- e-Hospital certificates or photocopies WILL NOT be accepted.
- f-One additional form of identification
- g-Two original, approved documents that verify your Utah residency
- h-Permit
- I-40 hour log sheet

- 5-You don't need a certificate of completion from Wright Driving, all scores are already loaded and submitted to the Drivers License Division online.
